Fine Arts- VISUAL ART STANDARDS

Kindergarten:1PE, 1PR, 1RE, and 4RE , First Grade: 2PE, 1PR, 4PR, and 2RE

Things you will need:

- Tin Foil
- Cardboard
- Washable paint (Red, Yellow, Blue)
- Q-tips
- Paint Brush
- Paint tray/ Paper Plate



What to Do:

- Take a piece of cardboard and stretch a piece of tin foil over and tape it down.
- On a paint tray add your paint. If you have the primary colors, red, yellow, and blue use all three. By using all three primary colors, children are able to mix colors and create new ones.
- If your child needs some inspiration, look up an artist that uses lots of color.
- After you have everything set up let the kids paint!
